

# GP clinical supervisor workshop for NHS England general practice pharmacist pilot



Health Education England (HEE), through the Centre for Pharmacy Postgraduate Education (CPPE), is leading the provision of the training pathway for all pharmacists employed as part of the NHS England pilot for pharmacists working in general practice.
